WHAT IS TN WARN?

WARN is a volunteer-based Water/Wastewater Agency Response Network that prepares for disasters and allows drinking water and wastewater systems in Tennessee to receive rapid mutual aid and assistance from other systems in an emergency.



OUR MISSION

The mission of TN WARN is to support and promote statewide emergency preparedness, disaster response, and mutual assistance matters for public and private drinking water and wastewater utilities.

WHAT IS MUTUAL AID?

Mutual aid is an agreement among emergency responders to lend assistance across jurisdictional boundaries.



WHAT ROLE DOES THE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT (MAA) PLAY?

WARNs are governed by a common mutual aid agreement. Utilities sign the MAA agreement which then allows them to share resources with any other system in TN that has also signed the agreement.

The agreement covers such issues as requesting assistance, giving assistance, reimbursement, workers' compensation, insurance, liability, and dispute resolution.

WHO CAN JOIN TN WARN?

TNWARN is available to all public and private drinking water and wastewater systems in Tennessee. Member response is strictly voluntary and is not mandated
